Alaska Dance Theatre (ADT) was founded in 1981 and is the premiere non-profit dance organization in Alaska, governed by a volunteer Board of Trustees. ADT provides training in a variety of classical ballet styles, including Russian, French and Italian techniques, as well as various contemporary dance styles. The school serves around 300 students and offers fall, spring and summer programs, and private lessons. Families can make monthly payments, or pay in full for the entire year. Additional fees, referred to as Production Fees, are charged to cover performance costs; costumes, choreography, other. - Annual Audit for the year ended June 30, 2020 conducted in accordance with U.S. Generally Accepted Auditing Standards; include tests of documentary evidence supporting the transactions recorded in the accounts; tests of the physical existence of inventories; direct confirmation of receivables; and, prepare a management letter to include any comments or recommendations regarding internal control or effectiveness and efficiency of ADT accounting procedures.
